PROCESS TO QUALIFY FOR UNIFORMS IN EAST BATON ROUGE PARISH

St. Vincent de Paul's Uniforms for Kids provides uniforms to elementary and middle school children (Head Start and Pre-K through 8th grade) who live in households at or below the federal poverty guidelines. **Children in Head Start must attend a Head Start run by the City of Baton Rouge-Parish of East Baton Rouge. We are unable to provide uniforms to Early Head Start students. Head Start students must be three by September 30 to qualify.**

Scheduling Appointments

We will schedule appointments for East Baton Rouge families **in person only at the St. Vincent de Paul Thrift Store, 2655 Plank Road, beginning June 27, from 9:30-3:00 each weekday, continuing until we have given out all appointment slots for available uniforms.**

The parent, grandparent, legal guardian, or other relatives can schedule an appointment. We're scheduling and qualifying applicants at the same time. When you come in for your appointment, you will need only to check in.

Bring These Documents with You

- 1. Your Picture I.d.**
- 2. Your Social Security #, your child (ren)'s Social Security #(s).**
- 3. Report cards for children 14 & older. As an alternative, a letter from the child's school giving his/her grade for the 11-12 school year.**
- 4. Proof of income (current food stamp letter, or check stub; Social Security or Disability award letter, or similar document).**
- 5. Birth certificates for Head Start Children.**

As you know, in East Baton Rouge Parish, we now have many schools run by various boards and organizations whose uniforms are different from the elementary and middle schools uniforms we were accustomed to. Please be aware that we may not be in a position to provide some school colors.
